Scope and Content Note

Scrapbook and photographs documenting the life and academic activities of Horace Smith of Covington, KY from 1871-1880. The scrapbook includes items from Smith's time as a student at Hanover College including newspaper clippings; poetry; report cards; Union Literary Society documents; calling cards; invitations; and programs from concerts, exhibitions, and commencements. There are also documents from his time as a medical student at the City University of New York. The collection includes photographs of friends and colleagues of Smith.

Historical Information

Horace Rawlins Smith was born in Cincinnati, Ohio on October 9, 1855. He attended Hanover College beginning in 1872 until about 1875. He taught in Hamilton, Ohio from 1876-1878 and then studied medicine at City University of New York and earned his M.D. in 1880. He received a Masters of Arts degree at Hanover College in 1881. From 1881-1883 he served as a medical missionary in China. He spent the remainder of his life working as a doctor in Pennsylvania. He died in Altoona, PA on Dec. 10, 1926.
