This collection contains loose family history pages from the Samuel Danner Bible located in the Duggan Library at Hanover College. The pages include birth and marriage information for the surnames Danner, Walters, Cain, and Sterrin from 1750-1838. Also included are a typed family history, ca. 1971, and a photograph of an unidentified man, ca. 1910-1920.

Jacob Danner immigrated to the United States from the state of Bavaria in Southern Germany in 1749 and settled in Pennsylvania. Several members of the family would later relocate to Virginia, Kentucky, and Indiana.
