The Jean Anderson Papers documents the life and career of Jean Anderson from 1894-1983. The collection includes materials related to her work as a French professor at Hanover College; her father Henry Anderson; her niece Ann Steinbrecher Windle; her personal and family life; her travels to Europe; Hanover College; Indiana history; family history. Documents includes correspondence, travel diaries, and newspaper clippings. Other topics include Hanover, Indiana in the Civil War, World War I, World War II, Adolf Hitler, and the Shewsbury-Windle House.

Jean Jussen Anderson was born in Chicago, Illinois on 18 August 1887 to Henry and Anna Jussen Anderson. She worked as a professor of French at Hanover College from 1922-1952. Anderson died in Madison, Indiana on 17 December 1977.
