1	1	Session Minutes	1837-1948	Includes transcribed from old notes listing site, date, signature of moderator, and names of attendees with new members received and names of elders, pastor, and often deacons. Meeting minutes. Early entries include both Milton and Cambridge City churches; disciplinary actions against members for inappropriate conduct (drinking, profanity, dancing, non-attendance); membership lists; Annual reports; financial records; attempts to increase members; Register rolls of trustees, elders, deacons, and communicants from founding in 1834 forward to 1900's with partial lists of marriages and deaths.
1	2	Congregational Records	1837-1926	Includes early records of Milton and Cambridge City churches with founding notes, lists of members and officers; Financial records
1	3	Annual Meeting and Sunday School Records	1927-1932	Financial information including pledge reports, treasurer's reports, and committee reports to the congregation; summaries of activities of socials, elections, mission work, and clubs.
1	4	Sunday School Records	1933-1948	Records of attendance, giving, and meetings of Sunday School. Includes class and teacher names.
1	5	My Path Bible Class	1927-1929	Notes on parties given by class members at their homes. Descriptions of games, costumes and desserts.
1	6	Sunday School Treasurer's Report	1932	Memos, computations, notes, and lists stuck in an open notebook cover.
1	7	Historical Documents	1908-1962	Church bulletins, histories, literary magazines, news clippings of church history, genealogical material, and receipts.
