Scope and Content Note

Documents and correspondence related to the McComb family spanning from 1788-1972. The collection contains McComb family genealogy, school at Hanover, correspondence between family members, inquiries about genealogy both from within and outside of the family, legal documents such as wills and land deeds, diary excerpts, etc. The photographs of this collection contain portraits, family photos, travels- New York, Europe and honeymoons, family homes, family reunions, weddings, etc. Much of the McComb family (the branch this collection focuses on) seems to have stayed in the Midwest in places such as Indiana and Ohio. However, some of the later generations can be found in California or New York. The topics addressed range from simple updates throughout the family to their time at Hanover, sermons, graduations, continued schooling, genealogy, etc.

Historical Information

The McComb Family Papers follows the McComb Family throughout the last half of the 17th century through the 20th century. Much of the family focus seems to be on Peter Hathaway Kemper McComb. PHK married Virginia Bell Hackett and they proceeded to have four children. PHK, his father, as well as his children all attended Hanover College. PHK himself attended Hanover Seminary and went on to become a Reverend before ending up back at Hanover as a professor of History and Political Science.

Organization

The collection is organized into 4 series: PHK McComb, Genealogy, Photographs, and Misc. Within these series there are subseries, PHK McComb- correspondence, sermons, church business, family including RC McComb, Ann S. McComb, Virginia McComb, and Lois Miller; genealogy- correspondence, family tree, little histories; Photos- family photos and portraits; Misc.-undated poem, letters...

1	2	RC McComb Diary Extracts	1826-1851	Diary extracts from RC McComb that show major events such as his mother's death and discourse in the church- in great detail
1	3	RC McComb at Hanover	1833-1836, unknown	Diary entries detailing daily life during seminary school at Hanover, most likely class notes from seminary, possible sermons
1	4	Catalogues, Programs, and Literary Societies	1834-1860	Catalogues of the Philaethean Society, programs, literary societies that RC McComb was involved in during his time at Hanover College

1	6	RC McComb Absence from the Church	March 1836- Feb. 1916	Correspondence pertaining to RC's absence from the church for an extended period of time, RC's request for absence as well as others reactions to it
1	7	Correspondence from PH Kemper to Ann S. McComb and her siblings	1836-1852	Letters from PH Kemper to Ann S. McComb detailing what's happening in their respective places, PHK writing to his children on a fairly regular basis
1	8	Ann S. McComb Correspondence	Nov. 1842-June 1874	Ann S. corresponding with her sister: talk of relatives, death of K. G. McComb and his funeral, congratulations of 25 years of marriage (between Ann S. and RC); a letter to Ann S. from her parents James and Judith Hathaway
1	9	RC McComb Correspondence	Feb. 1854-March 1868	Featuring letters from William Mason, John Ustic, D. Lattimove, J.D. Pollock, Adam Faris, J.B. Mkinley, Campbell Wakefield, B.H. Clinton, W.R. Jackson that pertain to the ongoing of the church, along with friends and sisters
1	10	Ann S. and RC McComb Correspondence	Sept. 1841-March 1856	A series of letters that occur while RC is away from Ann S. at home- they are filling each other in on what is happening in each of their respective places (Cincinnati and Madison County Ohio)
1	11	History of Old Cottage Farm House	Sept. 1834- Aug. 1884	Old Cottage house was built by PHK (the son of RC) and it is where his family resided for much of their life; this is discussed in the little histories of the house written by Rev. J.S. Kemper
1	12	PHK McComb Speeches Given as a Student	1862-1864	These are a collection of speeches given by PHK as a student at Hanover College during his time at the seminary school including such speeches as: The House of the Learned, Eloquence and its Power, The Ninth Speaker, Specialties, Excelsior Excelsior
1	13	PHK Correspondence in Relation to Genealogy	Oct. 1889- June 1905	Information regarding the Kearsley side of the family, the information regarding the Kearsley family begins with Jonathan Kearsley, two family trees, these inquiries span many years and many different leads
1	14	PHK Correspondence	June 1894-March 1914	Compiling general register, regarding appointment to Doctor of Divinity, to his father's church asking about records they have of his father, Ann S. selling the farm and buying new property

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1	15	PHK McComb Letters to his Wife	1912-1917	PHKM sends this series of letters to his wife because they are not together (geographically) for her birthday about how he wished they could be together for this special day
2	1	PHK McComb post-Hanover	Sept. 1873-Jan, 1912	PHKM asking to be released from his position in the Presbytery of St. Louis, donation list with names and amount, electing PHKM Emeritus Professor of the Chair of History and Political Science, the Hebrew Manuscript written to PHKM in regards to the Hebrew Scripture, the congregations final words to PHKM as their pastor
2	2	PHK Contents of Sermon Case	1865-1880	A poem that is mentioned in PHKM's autobiography, essay's, letter detailing his inability to perform the marriage ceremony without a license to wed
2	3	PHK Legal Documents	July 1887-Nov. 1942	Deed of William McComb and wife and PHKM is not named in the will, more inquiry responses to William McCombs will, proof of marriage of PHK McComb and Virginia Bell Hackett, petition of Presbyterian Church at Webster Groves
2	4	PHK McComb Autobiography Notes	unknown	PHKM started writing notes about his life for his autobiography and here is what seems to be the notes as well as what seems to be the first draft
2	5	PHK McComb Autobiography Notes	unknown	PHKM started writing notes about his life for his autobiography and here is what seems to be the notes as well as what seems to be the first draft
2	6	PHK McComb Autobiography	1913-1917	A bound copy of PHKM's autobiography notes for his children started in 1913

McComb	1854- Nov. 1954	Income and tax information, record of standing at Hanover College, answered letters of inquiries about her genealogy- specifically the Kemper side, coat of arms for the Kemper family given to her due to her family connection as well as her personal interest in the Kemper family (she published a book on the Kemper family genealogy in 1946) that also contains genealogy research for the Kemper family

3	1	Genealogy: McComb-Frontier Times	Jan.-June 1945	6 consecutive copies of Frontier times that make mention of the McComb family-relevant to McComb family history
3	2	Genealogy: McComb-Certificates, Newspaper Articles, Book Exerts	March 1898-1945	Lawyer certificate; certificate of election; newspaper articles regarding Thomas J. McComb; certificate of induction into the Oklahoma Supreme Court (T.J. McComb); newspaper article on Dr. J.W. McComb; Senate Resolution No. 70; book exerts about the McComb family origins and relation to other families; Emmerich Manual Training High School yearbook from 1945 featuring E.H. Kemper McComb; notes of Ruth McComb Harkness; A sword of Washington belonging to Kearsley family; Diploma from University of Louisville 1874 for J.W. McComb for a doctorate
