## **Collection Information:**

#### **Scope and Content Note**

Records (photocopies) of the Olivet Presbyterian Church in Evansville, Vanderburgh County, Indiana, dated 1892-2007. Documents include session minutes, church registers, and annual congregational meeting minutes. Topics include church history, building construction, membership lists, financial reports, Anti-Saloon league, Endeavor Society, Ladies aid Society, Sunday school, committee meetings, anniversaries, officer lists, anniversaries, World War II, flooding, African Americans, and dissolution of the relationship with the Presbyterian Church. Records also include vital statistics information including baptisms, marriages, and deaths.

#### **Historical Information**

In 1892, a group of missionaries began teaching Sunday school classes inside the Jefferson Ave. C.P. Church and later the Free Methodist Church. This group built a church in 1896 and, after a few years of short-term pastors, was officially named the Olivet Presbyterian Church by Reverend T.A. Wigginton and Reverend W. F. Padgett. Reverend Padgett became the church's first full-time pastor. After years of membership in the Presbyterian Church (USA), in 2006 the church applied for dismissal from the PC(USA) and subsequently joined the Evangelical Presbyterian Church.

2	5	Session Book	1943	Discussion of moving a vault from the manse to the church to store documents in. Membership instability continues. A petition to recall Dr. Pearcy from Indianapolis to Evansville to return as pastor in Olivet Church in Evansville. Hanover College mentioned page 20.
2	6	Session Book	1944	Pledge card for all members mailed. Long list of new members appears on page 43 with addresses. Extensive financial reports appear.

2	7	Session Book	1945	A major flood occurs in Evansville affecting the church. Changes in officers. The anti-saloon League remains active.
2	8	Session Book	1946	Programs for returning service men, financial reports, and major building renovations.
2	9	Session Book	1947	Annual meeting notes, lists of officers and teachers with focus this year on Sunday School. Reports from all church agencies. Long lists of new members.
2	10	Session Book	1948	Reports from all church agencies and committees. New member lists are long. Church extension plans include other sites in the city for outreach.
2	11	Session Book	1949	Elections of Deacons, Elders, Men's and women's ministry reports, reports from Sunday School, and formation of new committees.
2	12	Session Book	1950	Attendance report and plans for anniversary plans and extensive financial and committee reports.
